

What is the SRS Winter Series? FAQ's

Q. When is the Southern Ranch Sorting Winter Series?

- A. Our Winter series begins in October of every year and runs through April. We have monthly shows the third weekend of every month (may vary due to Holidays).

Q.What is the Southern Ranch Sorting Winter Series?

- A. The Winter Series is a Ranch Sorting event running 6 shows plus one final each year. It is a series of classes for all levels that runs for two consecutive days.

Q. What are your points and ratings systems?

Q. How many rides can I ride?

- A. All classes in the Winter Series, with the exception of Youth and the Open, can ride a max of **6 times**. It is **Pick 5, Draw 1**. There is **one required draw** in all classes.
- B. Youth class has a max of 3 rides. This class is all draws.
- C. Open Class is all draw- minimum of 3 rides with a maximum of 6 rides.

Q. Can I register early?

- A. Yes! You can register **the week of** our events by emailing SouthernRanchSorting@gmail.com or contacting [Heather Saslo](#) through FB messenger or text 570-497-7829 (cell). Please include how many rides total for each class you plan to ride. You can choose all draws or send in your picks. Please include the name of your picks, at least first name and last initial. You will receive confirmation that your rides have been received and will receive a reply with any questions.

Q. How do I qualify for the April finals in order to be eligible for the added money and prizes?

- A. All riders can qualify for finals by riding at least 4 of the 6 shows. During each show you must ride at least 2 rides in each of the classes you want to qualify for.

We will keep a running recording of Qualifiers by Class. If you do not qualify for finals you are ineligible to ride the April event.

Q. What does #? HC mean for the class names?

- A. The number of the class determines the highest combined rating for the team. For example if it is a #8 HC that means both riders' ratings must add up to a total of 8 or less.

Q. How do I know what my rating is?

- A. Prior to riding in a show you will be given a rider rating of 1-6. 1 being Novice though 6 being advanced. A detailed explanation of ratings can be found in our rule book. Q. What is the attire?

- A. All riders are required to wear western attire for any scheduled show. Cowboy hats are optional. No baseball hats permitted.
